



## ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

### LE MAS DE PIERRE

Since 2015, the hotel Le Mas de Pierre is part of a sustainable development and has implemented an environmental policy.

For this purpose, it plans to achieve the European Ecolabel certification and to maintain over time the actions undertaken for this certification.

Through this environmental policy, the hotel Le Mas de Pierre commits to:

- Comply with environmental legislation applicable to its activities
- Reduce the environmental impacts caused by its operation
- Promote the preservation of biodiversity and the protection of natural spaces, both in the management of its activities and in its partnerships
- Increase the awareness of its staff and partners on the importance of ecological actions
- Continually improve its environmental management system.

To meet its commitments, the hotel Le Mas de Pierre is moving towards:

- Regular monitoring of water and energy consumption
- A reduction of waste generation by organizing a selective sorting process and by reducing paper consumption,
- A proper management of its commercial relations with suppliers and subcontractors,
- A training of its staff in eco-friendly behaviors
- An involvement in its territory by promoting local and organic food procurement.

The Hotel Le Mas de Pierre has also made the choice to involve its guests in this approach by offering them the choice to respect the instructions described on the eco-cube available in their room.

For 2019, our ambition is to:

- Comply with all mandatory and optional criteria for the European Ecolabel certification.
- Reduce our waste generation by removing all individual containers we used (for welcoming products and the dishes at the pool).

We also invite our partners to work towards our environmental approach and particularly our suppliers by reducing packaging, whenever possible.
