

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY DOMAINE DU MAS DE PIERRE

Saint-Paul-de-Vence July, 15th. 2021

Since 2015, the Domaine du Mas de Pierre is part of a sustainable development and has implemented an environmental policy.

For this purpose, it obtained the European Ecolabel certification in June 2021 and to maintain over time the actions undertaken for this certification, in particular with the expansion and embellishment works that took place for more than 18 months (from October, 1. 2019 to April, 29. 2021).

Through this environmental policy, the Domaine du Mas de Pierre commits to:

- Comply with environmental legislation applicable to its activities.
- Reduce the environmental impacts caused by its operation.
- Promote the preservation of biodiversity and the protection of natural spaces, both in the management of its activities and in its partnerships.
- Increase the awareness of its staff and partners on the importance of eco-friendly actions.
- Continually improve its environmental management system.

To meet its commitments, the Domaine du Mas de Pierre is moving towards:

- Regular monitoring of water and energy consumption.
- A reduction of waste production by organizing a selective sorting process and by reducing paper consumption,
- A proper management of its commercial relations with suppliers and subcontractors,
- A training of its staff in eco-friendly behaviors.
- An involvement in its territory by promoting local and organic food procurement.

For 2021-2023, our ambition is to:

- Comply with all mandatory and optional criteria for the European Ecolabel certification.
- Adapt measures related to the health crisis (Covid-19) to our eco-responsible approach.
- Reduce our waste production by removing all individual containers we used (for welcoming products and the dishes at the pool).

We also invite our partners to work towards our environmental approach and particularly our suppliers by reducing packaging, whenever possible.
